Town of Lebanon VOTING OPTIONS 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

Hello voters! Did you know you have several options on how to cast your ballot for the November 3, 2020 election (and every election).

For the traditional voter who enjoys the excitement of Election Day, polls will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm at Lebanon Town Hall. Our election workers will be happy to assist you along with keeping the election facility as clean and safe as possible. Extra efforts will be taken to continually wipe down voting booths and election equipment throughout the day. For voters' convenience, hand sanitizer and masks will be available.

Not up for Election Day? Request an absentee ballot online at www.myvote.wi.gov and a ballot will be mailed to you. Voters may also request a mailed ballot by writing to the Town Clerk but be sure to include a copy of your photo ID with your request. The deadline for regular voters to request an absentee ballot by mail is 5:00 pm on Thursday October 29, 2020. Receiving absentee ballots by mail works great for travelers; those who have a suppressed immune system; or voters who just can't make it to the Town Hall during working hours. Please be sure to allow mailing time so the ballot is returned to the Town Hall on or before 8:00 pm on Election Day. Voted ballots can also be hand delivered to the Town Clerk at the Town Hall or they can be dropped in the Official Ballot Drop box located outside the South entrance to the Town Hall.

Voters can also vote in-person via absentee ballot at the Clerk's Office at the Town Hall prior to Election Day. Stop in when the Clerk is at the office or call her to make an appointment. In-person voting ends on Sunday, November 1, 2020, so plan ahead.
