NOTICE OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF LEBANON, DODGE COUNTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Thursday November 19, 2020, immediately following completion of the Public Hearing on the proposed 2021 Budget which begins at 7:30 PM, at the Town Hall, N1738 County Road R, a SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE ELECTORS, called by the Lebanon Town Board pursuant to Section 60.12(1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statues will be held for the following purposes:

- 1. To review and act upon the salaries of elected officials with any changes to take effect after the April 2021 Town Election.
- 2. To consider the adoption of a resolution by the Town Meeting of Electors endorsing a Town Board Resolution which proposes that the 2020 (payable in 2021) Town Levy exceed the State allowable levy limit under Section 66.0602 of the Wis. Statutes, specifically, increasing the Town Levy by 9.0 percent over the State allowable levy limit of \$504,444 which would increase the Town Levy by \$45,400, on an ongoing basis, resulting in a 2020 (payable 2021) levy of \$549,844.
- 3. To adopt the 2020 Town Tax Levy to be collected in 2021 pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) Wis. Statutes.
