Longtime Lebanon Town Chairman will not run for re-election in April. Lohny Fredrick filed a Notification of Noncandidacy. When Lohny Fredrick leaves office in April of 2021, he will have served the Town of Lebanon for 20 years as Town Chairman. Only one other person in the history of Lebanon has served longer as Town Chairman and that was John Lettow who served for 26 years from 1917 to 1943. Lohny Fredrick was first elected Town Chairman in April of 2001. During his tenure he has provided the Town of Lebanon with strong and steady leadership. He will be greatly missed.

Candidates for this vacant position as well as all the other Town Board positions will need to be nominated at the Lebanon Town Caucus which will be held on Thursday, January 14 at 7:30 pm at the Lebanon Town Hall. If more than two people are nominated for any position, a ballot vote will be taken at the caucus to narrow the field to a maximum of two candidates for each office.
