Batteries & Oil will be recycled - Ask attendant where to be placed.			
Oil will only be accepted in 1 gallon or 5 gallon sealed containers, clean and not leaking.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

November 4, 2023

All recycling items must be CLEAN OF FOOD.

Accepted recycling items can normally be co-mingled.

Plastic recycling includes all CLEANED plastic bottles and jars #1 to #7: soft drink bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles, FLATTENED cartons, etc. Check the bottom of the container. If you see the recycling symbol with a #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7 in the center, it is acceptable.

Metal recycling Includes aluminum cans, pie and baking pans, tin cans, metal food containers, EMPTY aerosol cans, and lids. Metal beverage cans, baking tins, foil, and food containers are also included in this material category.

Cardboard recycling Includes corrugated cardboard, shipping boxes, cereal and dry food boxes, shoe boxes, tissue boxes, moving boxes, detergent boxes, soda/beer cartons, and paper towel/toilet tissue rolls.

All boxes MUST BE FLATTENED for proper disposal.

Paper recycling Includes newspapers, inserts, labels, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, manila folders, letterhead, notebook paper, computer paper, envelopes (with windows), coupon books, index cards, calendars, and brown paper bags.

Glass recycling includes bottles and jars – lids must be REMOVED and separated and the item must be CLEANED of all food and liquid waste before being placed inside the container.

What can't I recycle?

- Styrofoam
- Window glass and mirrors
- Motor oil containers
- Chemical containers
- Shredded paper
- Plastic bags
- Ceramics or dishes
- Food waste
- Tires
- Yard Waste
- Car Batteries – Place in specified location
- Scrap metal – Place in specified location
- Electronic waste (TVs and computers) – Place in specified location
